PLATINUM JUBILEE CELEBRATIONS

Cllr Wilkins organised a very successful event at the Spring Cafe with residents to put forward ideas for the Platinum Jubilee Celebration.

A long discussion took place and the following resolutions were agreed:

RESOLVED: That Cllr Wilkins will pursue the application for a road closure on Bridlington Street (4 June 2022) from the church to the co-op for the purpose of a street party – people to bring their own food. Tables from the community centre/school may be available. 35/22

RESOLVED: That events will take place on Cross Hill, Cllr Wilkins will leaflet affected properties. 36/22

RESOLVED: That none commercial stalls will be offered free of charge – people to bring their own table etc. 37/22

RESOLVED: That risk assessments for all groups would need to be made by the group leaders. 38/22

RESOLVED: That resident (Tmc) will liaise with the school. 39/22

RESOLVED: That a gift would be purchased for the children and a decision on the gift would be made once numbers are confirmed. 40/22

RESOLVED: That 200 jubilee flags and bunting will be purchased. 41/22

RESOLVED: That purple organza bags/cards would be purchased if the gift was eventually decided as either 50p or £1 coins minted in 2022. 42/22

RESOLVED: That resident (Tmc) would ask shops/businesses for donations towards the event and monies will be paid to the parish council. 43/22
